Code of conduct for Adult members.

Urmston Sports Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of all its members & volunteers, ensuring a positive and enjoyable experience for all. As a member of USC, you are expected to abide by the following Code of Conduct:

- 2. Members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all members, staff and guests regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- 3. Members should recognise the valuable contribution made by the Staff as well as volunteers who give their time and resources to provide the service that the Club provides for you. Members should respect any rules directions or requests that are made with the consent of or on behalf of the General Committee.
- 4. Members should be a positive role model, treat other members, members of Staff and club volunteers and the Committees with the same level of respect that they would expect to be shown to them.
- 5. Members should be mindful to avoid the use of improper language.
- 6. Playing members should keep to agreed timings for all sports facilities courts, training and competitions or inform their Team Captains if they are going to be late or unavailable as early as is practicable.
- 7. Members must pay any match fees, coaching, tournaments or other events on the day of usage
- 8. Bullying of any sort will not be tolerated.
- 9. Members should encourage everyone to enjoy sport and understand that people have different motivations for taking part.
